

### Traditional Booth Designs

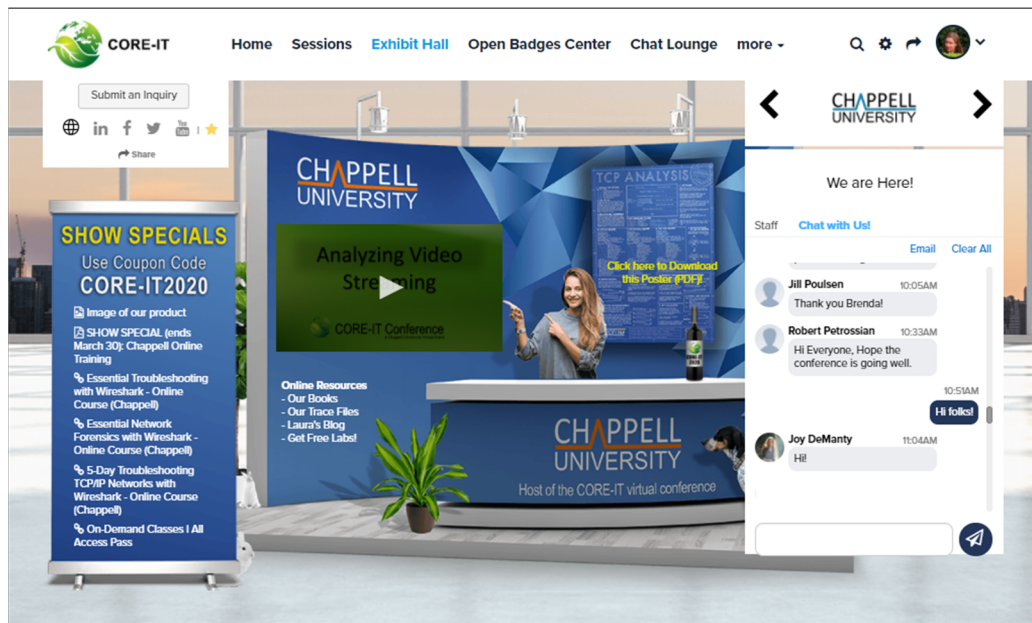


Figure 72. Traditional booths have more personality than modern booths.

Traditional booths require more work than modern booths, but that extra work enables the traditional booth to have some personality. Figure 72 provides an example of a traditional booth that contains a booth (backdrop and table), booth person, banner, plants, a dog, a couple of white rabbits, and a bottle of wine – all placed on a San Francisco skyline background.

We built our traditional booths using Envato Elements' trade show booth mock-ups and Adobe PhotoShop.

We choose traditional backgrounds for the CORE-IT event to bring personality to our event. We branded booths with the exhibitors' logos, colors, and elements related to the company.

Some booths included fun items such as a fish tank, a disco ball, a Darth Vader Lego Minifigure, and more.

Traditional booths require two graphic elements:

- background (floor, windows, outside view)
- background-in-background (the booth image)
